PLANNING APPLICATIONS ARE GOING ONLINE WITH CLOUDPERMIT

The Red River Planning District (RRPD) is pleased to introduce Cloudpermit for planning applications, bringing more of the planning application process online and making it easier for applicants and the community to access planning information.

Cloudpermit will provide a convenient, centralized workspace where applicants can submit applications, provide supporting documents, make payments, track application information and access updates, all online and available 24/7.

WHAT CAN BE SUBMITTED ONLINE?

The new online planning application process will support a range of planning applications and related submissions, including:

- Subdivisions
- Variations
- Conditional Uses
- Development Plan Amendments
- Rezoning Applications
- Zoning Memorandums
- Other planning-related applications and submissions

RRPD first introduced Cloudpermit for building permits in 2021, and the online system has been a great success. Building on that experience, RRPD is now expanding Cloudpermit to planning applications, providing applicants and the community with a more accessible, efficient and convenient way to participate in the planning process.

ONE PLACE FOR YOUR APPLICATION

Cloudpermit provides a centralized workspace for applicants to manage their planning application. Instead of relying on paper submissions or multiple methods of communication, applicants will be able to:



Submit electronically

Submit applications and supporting documents online.



Access Information 24/7

View application information and documents at a time that works for you.



Make online payments

Pay applicable application fees securely online.



Track your application

Access application information, correspondence, documents and updates through the online workspace.

Cloudpermit will also make planning information more accessible to the public.

Through the public-facing application information, community members will be able to view a map and information related to planning applications.

A QR code will provide a quick and convenient way for members of the public to access planning application information using a mobile device.

STAY INFORMED ABOUT AN APPLICATION

Want to know the outcome of a particular application?

Members of the public will have the ability to subscribe to an application and receive notification when a decision is issued. This provides a simple way to stay informed without having to continually check for updates.
